The suspension of student loan payments prompted by the COVID-19 pandemic, which included a 0% interest rate and stopped collections on defaulted loans, was <u>again extended to December 31, 2022</u>. # Did you ID? Update your demographic information today!

Calling all students! It's time to update your contact and demographic information. This means your current address, ethnicity, race, language, and gender.

Self-identification and updating your contact information can be done quickly through <u>Self-Service and Regis Hub</u>.

When you report your race, ethnicity, and gender, you help us have a clearer picture of the rich diversity of our community. When we have a full picture of our community, we are better able to design and implement programs and resources that are relevant to our entire student body – we reduce the guesswork and the assumptions. Self-identification also helps us identify any gaps in student retention and success. This is one of the key goals in our <u>Institutional Action Plan to Address Systemic Racism</u>.

We know that you may not see yourself in any of the options. We ask that you do your best to find an option that works best for you. If you really can't find something that reflects your identity, you have the option of declining to self-ID.

I also recommend that you view your specific degree requirements at the start of your academic program, and every semester thereafter.




Welcome to all new and returning students! Whether you're starting your first semester or approaching your last, the library is here to help!
