## **Do You Have Student Loans?**

Let the [Nurse Corps Loan Repayment Program](#) help! You may qualify for up to 85% of your unpaid debt. In return, you agree to serve at least two years in a [critical shortage facility](#) in a high need area or accredited school of nursing in a U.S. state or territory.

The Nurse Corps Loan Repayment Program application cycle opens soon! Here's how you can prepare:

### **Step 1: Determine if you're eligible.**

a. You must be a:

- Licensed registered nurse;
- Advanced practice registered nurse, such as a nurse practitioner; or
- Nurse faculty member

b. You received your nursing education from an accredited school of nursing located in a U.S. state or territory.

c. You work full-time in:

- An eligible CSF in a high need area (RNs, APRNs)
- An accredited school of nursing

### **Step 2: Learn how to apply.**

Review our [application website](#) and [subscribe to receive email](#) updates.

### **Step 3: Gather your documents.**

These include, but are not limited to, your: resume/CV; proof of U.S. Citizenship, U.S. National, or Lawful Permanent Resident; loan documentation; and transcripts.

## **Get Ready to Apply!**

The [National Health Service Corps \(NHSC\) Loan Repayment Programs](#) also provide funding to eligible nurses committed to serving in communities of need. Check out the [Nurse Corps-NHSC Comparison Tool](#) to see if you are eligible to apply.

## **Need help paying for graduate school? Seeking work experience?**
