

# Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) Transfer Admission Policy

## Transferring into the Nursing Program is a multi-step process:

- Transfer applicants for the Nursing major will be considered only if their current GPA (*or overall GPA, if they have attended multiple institutions*) is 3.0 or higher. Additionally, the minimum GPA requirement for math and science coursework is 2.7
- Transfer students applying to the Nursing major are not admitted directly into the program
- If you are offered admission to Regis College, it will be as an intended nursing major
- During this time as an intended nursing major (*a.k.a. period of residency*), you will be required to complete all nursing prerequisites – some of which are specific to the Regis nursing program and which must be taken at the College
- During the period of residency you must maintain a GPA of 3.0 or higher
- You must be enrolled for at least one full-time semester during the period of residency
- During the final step of the process, you will join all other students who have successfully completed the period of residency in competing for admission to the Nursing program
- Program admission is highly competitive and is not guaranteed

**To complete an application:** Applicants must submit the Common Application for Transfers ([www.commonapp.org](http://www.commonapp.org)) along with the \$50 application fee. You must also submit an official final high school transcript, GED or HiSET Score Report, official transcript(s) from all colleges/universities attended, a mid-term grade report if currently enrolled, a letter of recommendation from an instructor or employer (using the forms provided by [www.commonapp.org](http://www.commonapp.org)), and official SAT or ACT scores if you have been homeschooled or out of high school for less than 3 years.

**Priority Application Deadlines:** April 1<sup>st</sup> for Fall enrollment and November 1<sup>st</sup> for Spring enrollment

**Financial Aid:** Transfer students applying to the nursing program are eligible for need-based financial aid, but are not eligible for merit scholarships. Applicants for financial aid must submit:

- FAFSA ([www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov))
- Other supporting documentation as instructed by the Office of Financial Aid (781-768-7270)
