Students are encouraged to connect with their academic advisor throughout the summer by scheduling an appointment as needed.



Keeping your research organized can be time-consuming! Did you know that the library provides access to a tool that can help you manage and keep track of your citations? RefWorks is an online bibliography and citation management program that's available to the Regis community. With RefWorks, you can:

- Create a personal database of citations and sources
- Use folders and tags to organize your resources by themes or topics
- Import references from online databases, Google Scholar, and other sources
- Automatically format in-text citations and generate bibliographies (Note: Always check your citation format and make corrections as needed Even the most advanced citation management program can make mistakes!)
