Have you ever been working on a research assignment and run into an article that says “Request from Interlibrary loan”? These articles will need to be requested through our interlibrary loan service (ILL):

- Always remember your timeline! ILL operates from Monday morning through Friday afternoon, and requests can take up to 3 business days to be filled.
- If you’re working on a deadline, try using the “Full Text” filter to limit your search results to materials that are available right away!
- Check for your article in Google Scholar first!
- Make sure to print or download the article right away - there is a time limit to access. Once you download or print the article, it is yours to keep!

Scholarship Opportunities for Nursing
