Financial Aid

The 2024-2025 FAFSA will be released on December 31, 2023. It is recommended that students complete the FAFSA as soon as possible.

Key changes to the FAFSA for the 2024-2025 school year:

- New Student Aid Index (SAI): The Expected Family Contribution (EFC) is being replaced with the SAI, a simpler and more transparent measure of financial aid eligibility.
- Simplified family definitions: The FAFSA will align with tax return data to determine family size and dependency status.
- Electronic tax return retrieval: All applicants and contributors must consent to electronic tax return retrieval from the IRS, the FAFSA will be using the 2022 Tax Year

Regis College Nursing Student Loan Program

Are you looking for a way to finance your graduate nursing education with low interest rates and the potential for loan forgiveness? If so, the Regis College Nursing Student Loan Program (NSL) is a great option for you.

The NSL offers loans to qualified graduate nursing students at a fixed interest rate of 5%, which is lower than both the Unsubsidized Stafford Loan (7.05%) and the Graduate Plus loan (8.05%). Additionally, NSL loans are forgivable if consolidated with your current federal direct loans.

To be eligible for the NSL, you must be enrolled at least half-time in a graduate nursing program at Regis College and have a demonstrated financial need.
