

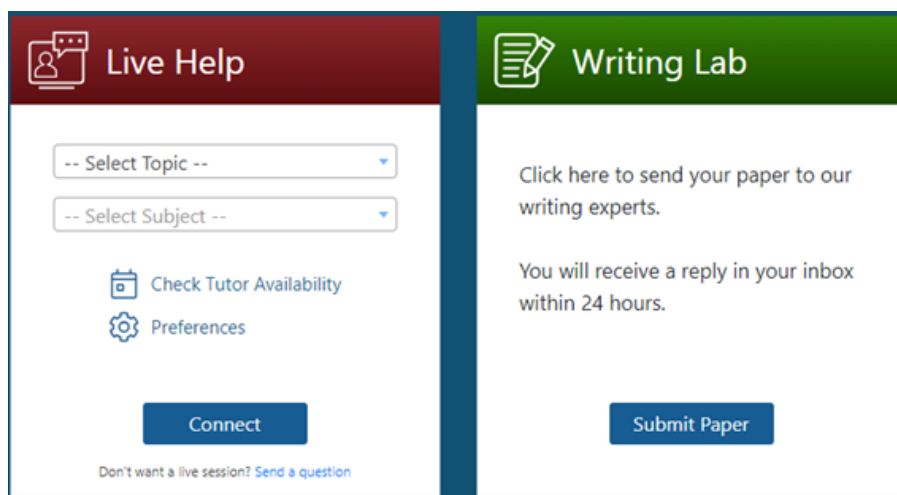


University Announcements
