If traveling north on Route 95/128

- Take exit 24 to Route 30 west
- Continue approximately two miles and make a right turn onto Wellesley Street
- Regis College is on the left.

If traveling south on Route 95/128

- Take exit 26 to Route 20 west
- Continue approximately one mile and make a left turn onto Wellesley Street
- Regis College is on the right.

If traveling east on the Massachusetts Turnpike (I-90)

- Take exit 14 to Route 30 west
- Continue approximately two miles and make a right turn onto Wellesley Street
- Regis College is on the left.

If traveling west on the Massachusetts Turnpike (I-90)

- Take exit 15 to Route 30 west
- Continue approximately two miles and make a right turn onto Wellesley Street
- Regis College is on the left.

From Route 9 in Wellesley

- Continue north on Weston Road which becomes Wellesley Street at the Weston/Wellesley town line.
- Stay straight on Wellesley Street and go across Route 30.
- Regis College is on the left.
