### A Message from the Registrar

All students who anticipate graduating in **May 2020** or **August 2020**, must complete the Application for Graduation on RegisAccess (under “Academic Planning”). **This form initiates the graduation audit process and is the only way our office knows who to evaluate for possible graduation.**

- Once you submit the application, you will receive a confirmation email. If you do not receive a confirmation, please resubmit your application through RegisAccess.
  - Submitting this application notifies the Registrar’s Office of your intent to graduate only. All graduation forms and degree audits must be approved by applicable advisors, program directors, and the Registrar’s Office.
  - Diplomas will be mailed (via regular USPS) to the address provided on your application roughly 6-8 weeks following your graduation date. If you do not provide an address on the application, your diploma will be mailed to the current address on file with the CSS. Regis College is not responsible for diplomas lost or damaged during the shipping process.
