As the semester wraps up and you finish your final assignments, make sure to check your work for APA Style. Here are a few reminders about resources that can help:

• The *Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association* (7th ed.) is the best tool to have at your fingertips. The APA manual details everything you

- need to know from writing style to in-text and reference list citations.
- The library's research guide, <u>APA Style</u>, <u>7th edition Citing Sources</u>, explains and addresses the major components of APA Style. It includes advice about <u>how to format your paper</u>, numerous examples of how to cite your sources (<u>both in-text and in the reference list</u>), and more.
- The <u>APA Style website</u> also provides useful information including the <u>Style and Grammar Guidelines</u> section and the <u>APA Style Blog</u>, which is run by a team of experts and addresses tricky questions about how to use APA correctly.
