 - 7.7 % of US population is still uninsured (25.3 million)

Infectious Disease Threats

- COVID now an endemic disease
- Increase in respiratory & other infectious diseases
 - RSV & Influenza
 - Measles, Polio & other vaccine preventable diseases
 - Sexually transmitted diseases (neonatal syphilis up)
 - Malaria & vector bourn diseases
- PEPFAR reauthorization
- Hep C & HIV control
- Adult vaccine program



- Environmental Health
 - Climate Change
 - Environmental issues (exposures, toxins, Clean Air Act, Clean Water Act)
 - Lead exposure Line replacement & dust
- Injury
 - Gun Violence Epidemic
 - Domestic violence
 - Violent extremism
 - Unintentional Injury (Falls, Pedestrian injury, other MVA)
 - Violence against health care workers
- Misinformation / Disinformation





- Healthcare reform that limits access to care










With all 3 branches in Republican hands can we finally get ACA in all states even if we must do so on their terms

■ Adopted and implemented (41 states including DC) ■ Not adopted (10 states)









Trump 2.0 Actions to Date

- Finding freeze has caused confusion, disrupted health care and
- Personnel decisions Secretary Kennedy poor choice; others mixed bag
- Personnel cuts Indiscriminate and destructive to capacity to do public's health
- NIH Indirect cut to 15% Destructive to research in short term, not real savings as many costs will simply shift to direct costs & any real savings will go to tax cut not more research
- Censorship, misinformation and disinformation is most concerning of all actions
- Political interference has eroded trust
- Plans to leave WHO
- DEI & health equity attacks
- FDA Delays in drug approvals & potential policy changes on reproductive health




CDC Specific Issues – Some Issues

- Personnel cuts indiscriminate and confusing
- Funding pauses & cuts interrupt core public health programs
 - Increase risk of injury, illness and death
- Communication pause to CDC staff
- Website alterations Censorship of specific words, data
- MMWR and other health communications delays
- Program interruptions WHO, global health
- Support of state & local health officials diminished
- U.S. Points of entry health screening capacity diminished
- ACIP & CDC/FDA Vaccine compensation meetings cancelled
