



Verification of Identity - Notary

Your FAFSA was selected for review by the U.S. Dept. of Education in a process called Verification. Federal Student Aid requires Regis to confirm the information you reported on your FAFSA prior to disbursing funds. To verify that you provided correct information, Regis will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and documents to the Office of Financial Aid.

WARNING: Anyone who purposely gives false or misleading information on this worksheet may be fined, sentenced to prison, or both.

The student is able to complete verification of their identity through one of three methods: in-person/on campus in the financial aid office, via Zoom video appointment, or by appointment with a notary public. In all circumstances a student must present a copy of an **unexpired** valid government-issued photo identification (ID) which can include the following:

- Driver's License
- State Issued ID
- U.S. Passport (book or card)
- Permanent Resident or Resident Alien Card (I-551)
- Certificate of Naturalization with recognizable photo
- State-issued voter ID
