## 2022-2023 Overview and Application for the Mary Jane England '59, MD President *Emerita* Scholarship

Like the Sisters of St. Joseph, Mary Jane England '59, M.D. is a woman ahead of the times. She pursued medicine when women were just beginning to break into the field. In government, business, and academe, she has stood out nationally as an innovative leader. Medicine, public health, and education have all benefited from Dr. England's vision and so, especially, has Regis College.

To honor Dr. England's achievements in health, and in positioning Regis College for the 21<sup>st</sup> century, as well as to celebrate her 10-year presidency of Regis College, the *Mary Jane England '59, M.D. President Emerita Scholarship* was established in 2010. Scholarship awards range from \$1,000 to \$10,000.

### CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

*Important note: Some students may not be eligible to receive this scholarship based on their current financial aid and scholarship package. ### To qualify, the applicant must:

- Be a full-time undergraduate sophomore or junior or graduate student, with at least one year of study remaining
- A student from the Young School of Nursing, the School of Health Sciences, or a full time sophomore or junior student in STEM from the School of Arts & Sciences
- Be an innovative leader

### Application Requirements

1. Complete the application on page 2 of this document
2. **Scholarly Essay:** Submit a two-page (double-spaced) personal essay, describing the ways in which you reflect the qualities of Dr. England. Also address how you would benefit financially from this scholarship.
3. **Resume:** Please enclose a current resume with this application. It is most helpful when the resume reflects employment and volunteer experiences that the Mary Jane England Scholarship Committee may find relevant to your candidacy.
4. **Two original letters of recommendations** for this scholarship, one from a Regis faculty member, and one from a Regis class peer. The person writing the recommendation must directly send a pdf document of their letter to [advancement@regiscollege.edu](mailto:advancement@regiscollege.edu) by the **March 18, 2022** deadline. The subject line should include "MJE Scholarship Letter of Recommendation" with the name of the applicant as well. It is the responsibility of the student to follow up with their peer and faculty member to ensure that the letter has been sent to [advancement@regiscollege.edu](mailto:advancement@regiscollege.edu).
5. Students should save all components of their application as one pdf file (application, resume, and essay) and email it to [advancement@regiscollege.edu](mailto:advancement@regiscollege.edu) (please note "MJE Scholarship Application" in the subject line of your email) by the **Friday, March 18, 2022** deadline to be considered for this scholarship for the 2022-2023 academic year.
