

With a keen awareness of social justice, you pursued degrees in economics and geography with an emphasis on physical planning from the University of the West Indies in Jamaica. It was during your time at graduate school that you recognized systemic change requires both a deep understanding of financial structures and the ability to design communities that uplift the most vulnerable. Continuing to witness the harsh realities of poverty, especially among homeless and abandoned children, you were moved to action. In 1978, with a loan of six hundred dollars, you built a basic school for the children living in a squatters' community, laying the foundation for what would become Mustard Seed Communities.

This realization led you to pursue post graduate degrees in philosophy and theology at Boston College. You were ordained a Catholic priest in 1984, embracing Matthew 25:40, you chose to care for "the least of these," dedicating yourself fully to the expansion of Mustard Seed Communities.

What began as a single home for a handful of children in Jamaica has grown into a global network of homes, schools, and small businesses across Central America, the Caribbean, and Africa. Today, Mustard Seed Communities cares for over 650 abandoned and disabled children and is the largest non-governmental organization in the Caribbean.

Through your profound ability to walk in another's shoes, you have received countless accolades. Yet for you, the greatest achievement is found in the lives of the over 15,000 individuals you helped through your mission. Your passion for a faith that does justice has moved generations of volunteers to selfless service, including the students at Regis, who bring hope to those in the greatest of need.

Academic ceremonies such as today's Commencement at Regis College date back to the twelfth and thirteenth centuries when modern-day universities were first taking form.

ACADEMIC PROCESSION

The procession begins with the Ceremonial Marshal carrying the mace, followed by the degree candidates, the faculty, and then the platform party including the Commencement speakers and members of the Board of Trustees. The President is the final person in the academic procession.

CEREMONIAL MACE

A mace was originally a weapon of war consisting of a long club with a ball of steel at the end. It was a symbol of authority and power. The academic mace has now become the symbol of the power colleges and universities have to confer degrees to candidates who have earned the privilege of the degree. The ceremonial or academic mace is carried in procession and placed on the stage whenever degrees are granted or when the faculty is assembled in formal academic dress.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

Academic regalia has its origin in the Middle Ages and varied in design until standardized by the American Intercollegiate Commission in 1894. The different styles of hoods, mortars, and gowns display the institution, academic discipline, and highest degree of the wearer.

Gowns

Each of the four academic degrees—associate, bachelor, master, and doctor—has its own distinctive gown. Associate and bachelor's gowns are distinguished by their long pointed sleeves. The master's gown has longer, narrow, closed sleeves extending below the knee; the arm is passed through a slit at the elbow. In contrast, the doctor's gown has full bell-shaped sleeves with three velvet bars across the sleeve and velvet bands down the front.

Hood

The most colorful and distinctive item of academic dress is the hood that passes around the neck and extends down the back. The doctor's is the largest of the hoods and the bachelor's the smallest. The hoods are lined with satin colors indicating the particular college or university that awarded the degree. The colors of Regis College are crimson and gold. The velvet border of the hood indicates the field of study in which the degree was earned. Below is a list of colors:

Cap and Tassel

The cap or "mortarboard" is uniform in design for all degrees and can have four, six, or eight sides. The tassel may be either black or the color of the field of learning; the tassel of the doctor's cap may be gold. The tassel is worn on the right side of the cap until the degree has been conferred and the graduates are instructed to change.
