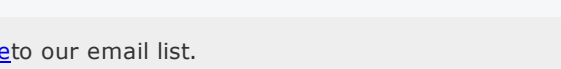
Flatley Scholars Application Is Now Open

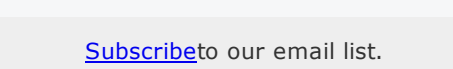
Regis Career Conference: January 2020

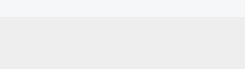

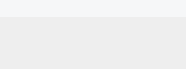
